## 2023 AMG Medal Policy

As at 14 June 2023

## Policy Objective

The aim of this policy is to outline the process and procedures for recognising and acknowledging achievements made within the Australian Masters Games (AMG) competition and to maintain consistency across all sports and for all future AMG.

## Policy Key Principles

1. The AMG will provide all sports with medals for presentation to place getters in all official AMG sport competitions (team and individual events).
2. Those participants, who have paid the full Games entry fee and the relevant Sport fee (including coaches and team managers if applicable), satisfy the age requirements set by the sport and have physically participated in the competition, will be awarded a place getters medal in accordance with the relevant sport's final results.
3. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all sport events and age categories however this will be subject to the participants completing the event within the rules of the sport.

## Procedures/Processes

1. Participants and teams will be awarded medals in accordance with their place getting. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to place getters as follows:
a. Where there are more than three participants (individuals or teams) in an event, medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters in that event.
b. Where there are only three (3) participants (individuals or teams) in an event, medals will be awarded to 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd place getters in that event.
c. Where there are only two (2) participants (individuals or teams) in an event, medals will be awarded to the participant(s) who finish 1st and 2 nd in that event.
d. In events where there is only one (1) participant (individual or team) a Gold medal will be awarded providing the participant(s) completes the event/competition
2. Participants in team sports are required to be listed on the official team list on the registration system in order to be eligible for a medal.
3. If there are equal placings, medals will be awarded as follows:
a. Equal 1st place - two
(2) Gold, one (1) Bronze
b. Equal 2nd place - one
(1) Gold, two
(2) Silver
c. Equal 3rd place - one
(1) Gold, one
(1) Silver and two
(2) Bronze
d. Equal 1st and equal 3rd placing - two (2) Gold and two
(2) Bronze
4. In the event of age categories or events being combined, the Sport Convenor will determine placings and eligibility within the rules/regulations of the sport.
5. Should a sport have a requirement to recognise the performance of competitors which is prohibitive in terms of the quantity or nature, by agreement of AMG management and the Sport Convenor, an alternative award can be agreed such as a certificate, badge or ribbon.
