4. Golf Program & Format

Given the level of entries received for the 2023 AMG Golf Program was sold out (120 players for each of the rounds), players are requested to note that the golf competition has been organised via shotgun (multi-tee) starts at all venues as follows:

Patawalonga Golf Course	- Shotgun Start at 7:45am	
Friday 13 th October	18 holes Individual Stableford	
West Lakes Golf Club	- Shotgun Start at 12:45pm	

The main reasons for draws being determined on this basis is due to:

- Providing surety to all players to enable them to fully plan their week in Adelaide;
- Best accommodate the many requests received from players to be grouped at the same starting time;
- Enable all gender, age and handicap categories to compete together at the same time with all medalists to be recognised accordingly.

Following an evaluation of the entries received and in accordance with the 2023 AMG Golf Program Competition Conditions, the following gender, age and handicap divisions have been determined and will be applicable at each venue:

Notes:

- (i) Due to the low number of entries received in the women's 30-39 and 40-49 age categories, these age groups have been combined with the women's 50-59 age group;
- (ii) Due to the low number of entries received in the men's 30-39 and 40-49 age categories, this age group has been combined with the men's 50-59 age group;
- (iii) Due to more than 20 entries being received in both the men's and women's 60-69 age categories, two separate handicap divisions have been determined for each category as follows:

Men 60-69: A Division (0 – 18.0) & B Division (18.1 – 54) Women 60-69: A Division (0 – 18.0) & B Division (18.1 – 54)





5. Medallions

On each day of the AMG golf competition, gold, silver and bronze medallions will be awarded to the winner, runner-up and third place getter in each of the age/gender/handicap category (as applicable) as outlined in section 4 above.

Should there be a tie for any medallion (including gold), in any age/gender either category or handicap division (where applicable), all positions shall be decided by the system of count back as specified by Golf Australia.

^{*} Golf carts are at the player's own expense and MUST be booked directly with the respective golf club as soon as possible. Golf Australia cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

^{**} Venue transfers are not provided for the 2023 Australian Masters Games Golf Program especially given the close proximity of the golf course to the Adelaide CBD.





8. Practice

In relation to practice facilities whilst in Adelaide, the main options are as follows:

In addition, the three event courses can all be played outside of the competition days via direct contact with each club. Course fees per round have been advised as follows:

- The Grange \$110 (Composite East and West course in play week before event to be booked through the Pro Shop on 08 8356 3070 quoting AMG)
- Patawalonga \$26 (to be booked through the Pro Shop on 08 8356 4811 quoting AMG)
- West Lakes \$ 50 (to be booked through the Pro Shop on 08 8268 3054 quoting AMG)

9. Handicaps

At registration on Monday 9th October (first day of golf competition), all players who have <u>not</u> previously provided a GolfLink Number with their initial entry will be required to present a valid GolfLink number or a current handicap record authenticated by their home club to verify their handicap. Failure to do so may mean the player is ineligible to participate.

As indicated above, following the close of entries, two separate handicap divisions have been determined for both the men's and women's 60-69 age category given a minimum of twenty entries were received for each age category. Players have been currently allocated to a handicap division on the basis of their stated GA handicap as at the close of entry. However, GA Handicaps will be updated prior to the first day's play and as required, players will be reallocated between the stated handicap divisions should their GA handicap change.

GA Handicaps will be updated between each round where possible and competitors must always play off their current GA handicap for each round.

10. Digital Scoring

All players are kindly requested to use their smartphones to enter scores throughout the event. Each player will receive an email with a unique scoring code on the day prior to each round. Please follow the link to do online scoring using your smart phone. PLEASE NOTE: This email will be sent via GolfBox (not Golf Australia) so please check your junk mail for the email.

It is appreciated that each player takes the time to enter scores after each hole. This is for the benefit of your family, friends and supporters following your scores remotely.

A physical scorecard will also be given to each player upon registration to be used by any players not able or willing to score on their smartphones.





11. Dress Regulations

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the host clubs dress regulations (as available on each club's Website as follows) whilst participating in the event.

- The Grange Golf Club
- West Beach Parks
- West Lakes Golf Club

Any player not adhering to the Host Club's dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie not adhering to the Host Club's dress regulations will be requested to leave the course. Tournament staff have been authorised to deny any person not suitably dressed the right to play on the course.

12. Course Care / Club Regulations

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used, pitch marks are to be repaired, and bunkers raked following play at each course. Mobile phones are only to be used on the course in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GA Code of Conduct.

13. Presentations

On each day of competition, Australian Masters Games gold, silver and bronze medallions will be awarded to the leading players in each age/gender category and handicap division (as applicable). The medallions will be presented at the conclusion of play for each age/gender category (including submission & checking of all scorecards) and will commence as soon as possible after the event.

It would be appreciated if as many competitors as possible remain for the presentations to acknowledge the respective medal winners.

15. Rules Officials

Rules Officials will be on course each day. For more information regarding rules officials on the day of play, please refer to the local rules sheet.

16. Slow Play

Rule 5.6b will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to the application of penalties.





17. Suspension of Play

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be one short siren blast. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 5.7b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

18. Distance Measuring Devices

Distance Measuring devices are permitted during the championships in accordance to Rule 4.3a.


