As a volunteer assisting the Australian Masters Games (AMG), I agree that at all times I will adhere to the Workforce Code of Conduct.

In return, I understand that AMG shall use all reasonable endeavors to provide:

- A safe and enjoyable environment in which to perform my tasks and duties;
- Training and supervision to enable me to carry out my duties as a Games volunteer;
- Recognition of my status as a volunteer, including benefits such as meals and uniforms depending on the nature of my volunteer role;
- A mechanism to report any unsafe or unsatisfactory situations that I could be faced with.

I acknowledge and agree that I undertake my duties as a volunteer for AMG at my own risk and have no claim against AMG, UniSport Australia or the Sport Committees for any loss suffered by me.

I also acknowledge and agree that AMG reserves all its rights to supplement, amend or otherwise vary any and all Terms and Conditions, and policies and procedures that affect my role as a Games volunteer at any time and without notice. AMG also reserves all its rights to vary or change my responsibilities as a volunteer or withdraw its appointment of me as a volunteer at any time, without being required to show cause.

I understand that the information I have provided to the Australian Masters Games is necessary for the objectives of AMG. I acknowledge and agree that the information will only be used for the objectives of AMG. I understand that I will be able to access the information I have provided by contacting AMG.

Volunteer information may be disclosed by the AMG to Games partners for the sole purpose of facilitating volunteer services for the Games.
