Events and Divisions

Individual event 21-23 October 2025:

• Mens Singles: 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+

• Womens Singles: 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+

Mens Doubles: 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+

• Womens Doubles: 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+

Mixed Doubles: 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+

• Mixed Teams: 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+

Players can play in a maximum of two different age brackets. If there are not enough entries in a particular Age Bracket or Division, certain events may be combined

Team event (18-20 October 2025):

- The teams event will consist of 4 individual ties (this is dependent on registration numbers)
 - o (minimum squad size is 4 2x male 2x female)
 - Maximum squad size: 6
- 1 x Men's Doubles 1 x Women's Doubles 2 x Mixed Doubles
- A maximum number of 4 players can be used per match and each player must play a maximum of 2 individual ties within a match.
- For the teams event ONLY, one player may be allowed per team who is under the minimum age of a particular age bracket if their date of birth is within 12 months of said age bracket.

• Any one player is not permitted to play in more than one team for the Team Event.

Age Requirements

- Age determined as at 8 October 2025
- Minimum age 35 years

Grading

- Complete beginners should also indicate and nominate for Division 3 of their age group.
- Ex state or national players MUST enter in division 1 of their age groups
- Division 1, 2 and 3 offered for all events in team and individual.

Seeding

• Seeding will be based on the results of the previous AMG event in South Australia 2023.

- The competition will be conducted under Badminton World Federation (BWF) rules.
- The tournament organisers reserve the right to modify the rules above as necessary to conduct the AMG 2025.
- The scoring format and draw structures will be TBC until entries are finalised

All players submitting entries for the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions, rules & regulations under which the tournament events are to be conducted. The Tournament Organiser will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this Tournament. Players agree to indemnify the Tournament Organiser, its officers and agents against all claims, demands, actions and liabilities of any kind (other than due to wilful negligence) arising in the course of participating in the Tournament. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and/or hospitalisation shall be borne by the player or Member Association of the player/official concerned.

Entries: Entries may be closed early if maximum no. of entries have been received in an event. The Tournament Organiser can regrade a player or reject an entry.

Other Conditions:

- 1. Players will umpire or line-judge some matches as required by the Tournament officials.
- 2. Appropriate badminton attire must be worn when playing on court. Non-marking shoes must be worn at all times in the hall. If anyone is found with shoes that mark, they will risk disqualification.
- 3. No refund of entry fee is available except for allowed withdrawals or events cancelled by the Tournament Organiser.
- 4. The Tournament Organiser/Referee reserves the right to vary any conditions or regulations.
- 5. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Organiser is final.
