

2025 AMG International Participant Policy

As of 29 January 2025.

Policy Objective

The aim of this policy is to outline the guidelines associated with participation by an international competitor in the Australian Masters Games (AMG).

Policy Key Principles

- 1. This policy applies to all international AMG participants and supporters who seek to register for the AMG.
- 2. AMG accepts international participants and supporters from all countries subject to international border and visa requirements.
- 3. Specific registration terms apply for participants from South Asia. Please email amg.rego@unisport.com.au for more information.
- 4. AMG will provide participants and supporters with proof of registration, when all registration and associated fees have been paid and any specific additional requirements have been met.
- 5. AMG project management team will not supply visas or citizen sponsorship to any participant or supporter.
- 6. All immigration associated documentation to legally enter Australia is the responsibility of the participant.
- 7. AMG will under no circumstance agree to any financial undertaking regarding a participant's or supporter's visa or immigration situation.
- 8. AMG will not provide accommodation, local transport or health services to participants or supporters.
- 9. AMG recommends all international participants and supporters commence the procedure associated with obtaining their visa to visit Australia at least 10-12 weeks before their intended date of travel.
- 10. The Australian Government is the sole authority to provide visas to enter Australia through the Department of Home Affairs.

 - c. The Australian Government requires all international visitors to comply with its health and character requirements as part of the visa application process. Information on these is available here:

- 11. All international participants must abide by any mandatory quarantine period set by the relevant State government when entering the country from abroad or interstate. All quarantine related arrangements and associated costs are the sole responsibility of the participant.
- 12. It is the sole responsibility of the participant to organise any COVID-19 screening and associated documentation in advance of their arrival if deemed necessary at the time.
- 13. AMG strongly recommends international participants arrange **comprehensive international travel insurance** prior to their departure.
- 14. All participants (both Australian and International) are responsible for the research, booking and payment of all travel requirements (including accommodation) related to the AMG.
