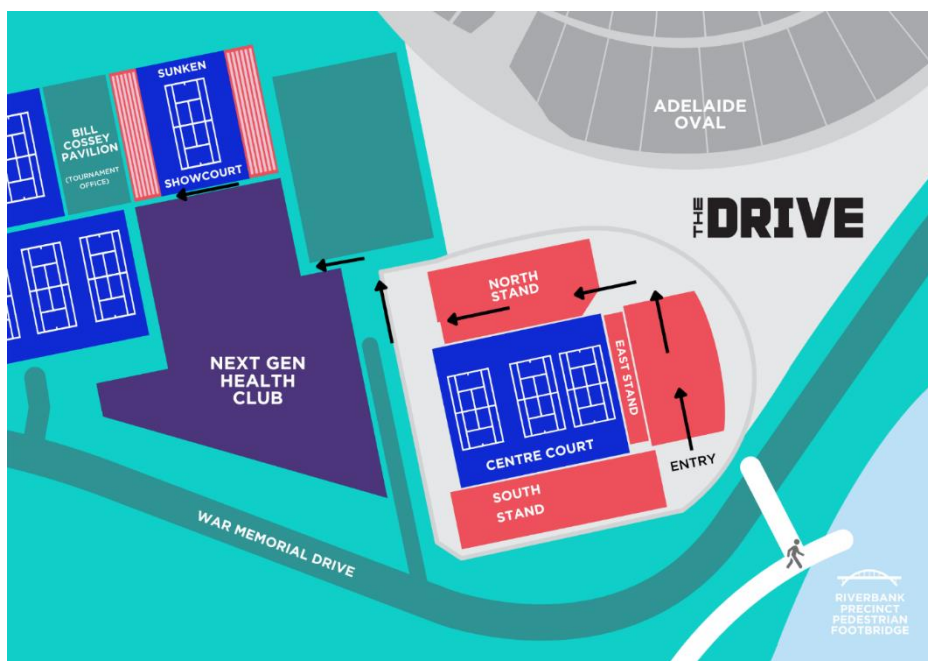
VENUE ENTRY

Entry into the venue will be through Tennis SA's venue 'The Drive'. Please see map.

There will be 2 staff members on the Saturday, Sunday and Monday to assist you in getting to the correct spot to sign in for your matches.

Please make sure you do not enter through 'Next Generation Health Club' there will be signs assisting you to walk to the correct location.

Once you do enter through, please follow the signage that will take you to the tournament desk.





FORMAT

Singles will be 1 set to 6 with a tiebreak at 5 all – normal deuce.

Doubles will be 1 set to 6 with a tiebreak at 5 all – no ad deuce.

SURFACE

The tournament will be played across both hardcourt and grass. Please see what age groups are on what surface below.

Hard Courts – 30+ to 55+ age brackets (combined age doubles up to 100+)

Grass Courts – 60+ and older age brackets (combined age doubles 110+ and older)

BALL

The Tennis ball used for all matches on hardcourt and grass will be the Dunlop Australian Open ball.

CHECK IN TIME

Please make sure you check in at the tournament desk at least 15 minutes before your scheduled match time.

UMPIRES

There will be 3 court supervisors available at all times for the duration of the tournament to deal with any on court disputes. Anything that needs to be taken further, will be handled at the tournament desk.

INCELEMENT WEATHER/DELAYS

During the tournament if there any major delays or weather has impacted play, an update will be available on the tournament webpage.

TOILETS

There are toilets available in the pavilion where the tournament desk is located, as well as the next generation complex.



SPORTS TRAINERS

There will be 2 sports trainers available for the duration of the tournament. They are there to deal with any injuries on court. Taping can be provided if you have your own but will only happen if they have time.

They will be located in the Pavilion where the tournament desk is.

PARKING

There is no onsite parking at the Drive and as well as next generation health clubs, parking is only for members. Please see alternate options below.

War Memorial Drive

There is free parking available on war memorial drive, where the north Adelaide golf course is located. No time limit on the weekends but there is a 4 hour time limit – Monday to Friday.

Adelaide Oval

Convention Centre

There is also parking available at the convention centre, which is a short walk across the riverbank pedestrian bridge to The Drive.

RE-STRINGING

Overnight re-stringing will be available. Please drop off your racquet before 4pm each day at the tournament desk and fill out the restringing information. Your racquet will be restrung overnight and available for pick up the next day. Pick up will be at the tournament desk.

All information on strings, payment will be available at the tournament desk.

CATERING

Catering will be available out of the Pavilion where the tournament desk is located. They will be serving water, soft drink, as well as grab and go food.

If you would like a larger meal, the café inside the Next Generation complex will be open for Masters Games competitors.

You can also get food at Koffee Ink which is next door at Adelaide Oval.

NEXT GENERATION HEALTH CLUB

Due to Next Generation Health Club being a members only health club. The Café and toilets are only available for Masters Games participants. The gym, pool and any other facilities are off limits.
